Judicial Tenure Commission Recommends Judges For Reappointment To Senior Status

This is to notify members of the bar and the general public that the Commission has submitted its report to Chief Judge Eric T. Washington concerning the qualifications and fitness of Judge Warren R. King to continue serving as a Senior Judge of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals. The Commission evaluated Judge King's performance and activities, since his reappointment as a Senior Judge four years ago, and based on that evaluation the Commission recommended Judge King's reappointment as a Senior Judge.

The Commission also submitted its reports to Chief Judge Lee F. Satterfield concerning the qualifications and fitness of Judges Kaye K. Christian, Brook Hedge, and Judith E. Retchin to continue serving as Senior Judges of the Superior Court of the District of Columbia. The Commission evaluated the performance and activities of the three Judges since their appointment four years ago, and based on those evaluations, the Commission recommended the reappointment of Judges Christian, Hedge, and Retchin as Senior Judges.

The decision to appoint or reappointment a Senior Judge candidate must be made by the Chief Judge of the candidate's Court within 30 days after receipt of the Commission's recommendations and findings. The decision of the Chief Judge regarding such appointment is final. The Commission was notified by Chief Judge Washington that he reappointed Judge King to a two-year term as a Senior Judge, and the Commission also was notified by Chief Judge Satterfield that he had reappointed Judges Christian, Hedge, and Retchin to additional four-year terms as Senior Judges.
