

The District of Columbia Commission on Judicial Disabilities and Tenure has carefully reviewed and thoroughly investigated Ms. Shatzman's complaint concerning Judge Steven N. Berk, which was filed with the Commission earlier this year.

The Commission's investigation included a review of all information provided by Ms. Shatzman as well as information gathered independently by the Commission. As the Commission's Special Counsel communicated to Ms. Mueting previously in response to her inquiry this fall, the Commission's investigation did not support (and, in some instances, refuted) material aspects of Ms. Shatzman's complaint and, therefore, the Commission has dismissed the complaint for lack of merit.
